## Admission to Copleston High School – Wednesday 6 September 2023 Britannia, Clifford Road and Sidegate

We are taking this opportunity to give you final instructions for your child's Induction Days on **Monday 26 and Tuesday 27 June** and for the first day of term in September 2023.

We are in the process of visiting your child in their Primary School. The next time we will meet your child is on our Induction Days. Below is a reminder of the schedule for those two days:

- 8.20 a.m. To arrive at the main door into school in Primary School uniform. To bring normal writing equipment and a calculator. To bring his/her usual PE kit on the Monday together with sun hat, sun cream and water each day. If your child attends our main feeder Primary Schools, to bring his/her Mathematics Exercise Book and his/her Forensic Science Booklet. If your child attends one of the other Primary Schools, he/she will be provided with these on the day.
- **Monday** <u>All</u> the pupils will be receiving a <u>free</u> school meal, or they can bring a packed lunch.
- **Tuesday** Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch or money for a school lunch (£2.20 for a meal deal Main Meal and Dessert or Water, or £1.80 for just Main Meal) from the canteen (see menu below). The Primary Schools have already informed us of those who receive a free lunch. Drinks are available to purchase from 60p to £1.10 each.

3.10 p.m. End of the School Day. Please ensure that your child knows where you are going to meet them if you need to collect them.

Year 7 Form Groups for September will be sorted after the Induction Days have taken place, so your child will meet their Form Tutor on their first day in September.

Student Leaders will accompany groups of Year 6 pupils each day taking them to each lesson, to break and to lunch. At lunchtime, pupils having canteen lunches will be shown where to wait and queue. As they enter the canteen, there will be 4 - 5 different counters from which to buy lunch. There are designated tables for Year 6s and 7s.

The first day of the new term is Wednesday 6 September 2023. Pupils should arrive at 8.20 a.m. in the Main Hall for an 8.30 a.m. start. Please note school will end for all **Year 7** at the usual time of 3.10 p.m.

We are looking forward to seeing your child again on the Induction Days and we hope he/she enjoys the experience. We look forward to meeting you on Wednesday 28 June.
